

Please refer to the Instructions for Authors section below before submitting an Article/Manuscript. Publication invites authors to submit manuscripts under the following heads:

1. Article: An article is thorough analysis of current legal issues being a content for debate nationally, or internationally that could possibly have an impact on our society. These can be submitted in two formats
 - a. Short articles: The word limit for articles is between 2,500 to 3,500 words excluding footnotes.
 - b. Long articles: The word limit for articles is between 4,000 to 5,500 words excluding footnotes.
2. Book Reviews: A book review should focus on either an autobiography authored by a lawyer which could inspire aspirants and practitioners in the legal field or focus on a practical issue that is important to know in the legal profession. The word limit for book review is between 1,000 to 2,500 words.
3. Case Comments: A case comment should be a composite comment on some of the leading judgments by various Indian and International courts. The word limit should be between 1,000- 1,500 words.

Publication will procure contributions in form of Articles, or Book Reviews as rolling submissions for its forthcoming issues as per the following guidelines.

Submission Guidelines

1. The work submitted shall be original and unpublished. Plagiarism of any kind is prohibited.
2. Maximum Co-Authorship of two persons is allowed.
3. Every paper, article or Case Comment should have an Abstract not exceeding 300 words. The Abstract should be in Times New Roman, Font Size 12 and may have a maximum of five keywords in alphabetical order separated by commas.
4. The title of the paper should be in Times New Roman, Font Size 14, Bold and Center-Aligned followed by the names of the authors along with their Affiliations in Size 12 as Footnotes.
5. A margin of 1 inch (2.54 cm) should be left on all the sides.
6. All articles/book reviews submitted should be typed in font Times New Roman with font size 12, line spacing 1.5; Justified.
7. Footnotes cited in the manuscript should be typed in font Times New Roman with font size 10, line spacing 1; Justified.
8. The text and citation must conform to the 19 th Edition of the Bluebook: A uniform system of citation.
9. The manuscripts should be submitted online in MS Word format at www.jusdicere.co.in/manuscript-submission

Review Of Articles/Book Reviews/Case Comments

The articles/book reviews/case comments submitted for publication should be an original work of the author and should have not been published previously or currently is submitted for publication

in any electronic or print media. The author will be responsible for the accuracy of statement of facts, opinions or views stated in the submitted manuscript. In case of any plagiarism found in the contents of submitted manuscript, the manuscript will be rejected. The final discretion as to the acceptance of the manuscripts rests with the Board of Editors.

Peer Review

There may be a peer review of each article submitted to the Board of Editors for publications by eminent scholars in the field of law on which the article/book review is focusing as part of the selection process for publication in the forthcoming issue. However, the same is subject to the discretion of the Board of Editors.

Copyright
